Report on the university commitment to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals 2020 – 2021



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Initiative 1.

The non-profit organization "KazNPU named after Abay" in 2020-2021 for the implementation of SDG 1 provides support to low-income students:

Indicators:

Provided benefits (discounts from 10% to 100%) for 1,237 students from the most vulnerable groups: 17 orphans, 24 students with special educational needs, 1,020 students from socially vulnerable categories were able to study for free.

- 33 orphans were provided with monetary compensation for food;
- 11 orphans received free accommodation in university dormitories;
- 13 graduating orphans received monetary compensation and lump sum payments.

Initiative 2.

"KazNPU named after Abay" in order to fight poverty creates opportunities for different people to learn new skills in order to find employment and earn a living.

For this purpose, the "Silver University" of Abay University was created - an educational space for adult education: computer literacy and IT skills courses, art courses, language courses, various handicraft techniques, fitness, dance, psycho-pedagogical school, the basics of financial literacy, etc.

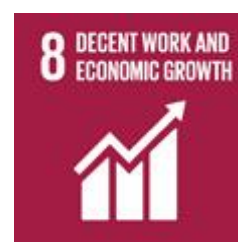
Knowing how to work remotely is one of the most important competencies for overcoming the effects of the pandemic

Indicators:

In the academic year 2020/2021, work was carried out to improve the pedagogical and research competencies of the teaching staff of Abay University:

- Summer online school "Digital Educator" 730 teachers of the university, 60 teachers of schools in Almaty were trained;
- Summer school: "Experience and problems of higher pedagogical education", 1047 participants;
- Winter School: "Pedagogical Education in the Distance Learning Format", 1127 participants.
- The "Winter School 2021", organized by the Professional Development Center of the Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay, was attended by UNESCO experts with a training on the implementation of distance learning.

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Initiative 3.

Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay in 2020-2021 to implement SDG 2 - eradicate hunger - carried out the following activities:

1. organization of affordable and quality food for students, employees and visitors to the university.
2. Assignment of monetary compensation for meals for low-income students.

Indicators:

1. Canteens and cafeterias work in academic buildings of the university to organize affordable and healthy meals for students.
2. 33 orphaned children were assigned a monetary compensation for food.

Initiative 4.

In KazNPU named after Abay to implement the SDG 3 - good health and well-being, the university developed a program for the formation of a healthy lifestyle (2021).

Indicators:

To provide preventive and emergency medical care there is a health center, in the educational and sports complex named after M. Auezov. M.Auezov and educational buildings 1, 5, 10 medical points for first aid.

The medical center employs:

Zhabbarkhanova Aliya Abbasovna - therapist.

Nurbekova Gulmira Masimzhanovna - therapist.

The main task of the medical center is to improve the health of the team.

The activities of the medical center is aimed at creating favorable conditions for the educational process, as well as the reduction and prevention of disease among students and staff.

The main activities of the medical center and health centers of the university are aimed at:

- Providing emergency primary health care to employees and students for acute and sudden illnesses, injuries, poisonings and other accidents before the arrival of the ambulance team;

- Provision of necessary medicines;

- Carrying out primary diagnostics in accordance with the available equipment;

- Monitoring the implementation of recommendations on the results of medical examinations of students;

- Carrying out annual medical examinations in accordance with current normative-legal documents in the field of health care, orders and instructions of the University administration;

- Involvement in the University activities aimed at educating students the qualities necessary to preserve and strengthen their moral and physical health, spiritual development and self-improvement;

- Organization and control of anti-epidemic measures on the territory of the University;

- Medical accompaniment of students at sport events;

- Health education work.

Medical care for students of Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay, including monitoring and ensuring the timely passing of medical examinations, is also carried out in the Health Center.

Initiative 5.

Introducing students to healthy lifestyles through sports

Indicators:

In order to promote grassroots sports among young people 15 events were organized: 13 university and 2 city-wide competitions. At the end of the XI Summer Universiade, the university's student athletes won a total of 167 medals, including 18 gold medals and 47 bronze medals.

University students won 167 medals in total, 18 of which were gold, 47 and 102 bronze medals, thus taking third place in the team event team classification among 60 teams of other higher education establishments.

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Initiative 6.

At Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay, inclusiveness and accessibility of education is achieved through the implementation of one of the key values of the university - equal rights to receive a quality teacher education, regardless of race, nation, gender, social status.

Indicators:

Provides students with the opportunity to study in one of three languages: Kazakh, Russian, English.

In the academic year 2020/21 in these three languages, the university operated 289 educational programs (EPs):

- 134 EPs of bachelor's degree,
- 99 master's degree programs,
- 56 PP doctoral programs.

Initiative 7. The University has a permanent representation in the Internet space - a web portal under the second-level domain name: <https://abaiuniversity.edu.kz>.

Indicators:

In 2020/2021 academic year in the framework of digitalization of educational activities: the transition to the online mode of learning, for teaching staff and students implemented MicrosoftOffice 365 platform; introduced control and measurement of knowledge: using proctoring knowledge control, "Anti-Plagiarism".

Initiative 8.

The university conducts professional development courses to provide lifelong learning (LLL).

Indicators:

In the 2020-2021 academic year 108 employees of the regional and district methodological offices underwent professional development under the plans of the CPC and DO course activities (in the 2018-2019 academic year trained - 48 employees of RMC, 2019-2020 academic year trained - 22 employees of RMC).

Winter and Summer Schools for Abai University faculty members have become traditional since the 2018-2019 academic year.

In the 2020/2021 academic year, work was carried out to improve the pedagogical and research competencies of Abai University faculty:

- Summer online school "Digital Educator", 730 teachers of the University, 60 teachers of schools in Almaty were trained;
- Summer school: "Experience and problems of the higher pedagogical education", 1047 participants;



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- Winter School: "Pedagogical education in a distance learning format", 1127 participants.

Initiative 9.

University lecturers conduct guest open lectures.

Indicators:

During the 2019/2020 academic year, 356 University lecturers served 30 hours each at the school. There were 34 special elective courses and 184 lectures for students, 148 workshops, master classes for school teachers, and 65 online lessons developed and posted on YouTube and Facebook. Under the guidance of the University's teaching staff, 374 students participated in Olympiads and contests, and 102 of them became winners.

Initiative 10.

The teaching staff of the University is constantly improving the quality of educational programs and teaching through the approbation of scientific ideas in publications for scientific journals and in the reports of scientific conferences.

Indicators:

In order to improve the competitiveness and quality of educational services the University participates in reputable international rankings. According to the results of 2020/21 positions of KazNPU named after Abay:

- QS World University Ranking-2022 - position 551-560, 5th place among Kazakhstani universities (2021 - 601-650);

- In QS Graduate Employability Rankings 2022 - position 501+, 2nd place among Kazakhstani universities;

- In UI Green Metric World University Rankings 2021 - position 659.

KazNPU named after Abay cooperates with Kazakhstani accreditation agencies: NAAR, NACO, KAZSEE.

- In the National rating of the best pedagogical universities of Kazakhstan 2021 (NACO) - 1st place;

- In TOP-20 National rating of universities of RK - 2021: General rating of RK (NAAR) - the 4th place;

- Institutional ranking by areas of bachelor's degree educational programs in the field of "Pedagogical Sciences" (NAAR) - 1 place;

- Institutional ranking by areas of educational programs of Master's degree in the direction of "Pedagogical Sciences" (NAAR) - 4 place;

- Institutional rating by the areas of educational programs for doctoral degree in the direction of "Teaching Sciences" (NAAR) -1 place;



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- **Kazakhstan 2050 - national rating for innovation and academic excellence Institutional ranking (KAZSEE) -1 place.**

Initiative 11.

Questioning. In order to study the level of students' satisfaction with the quality of educational activity and further work on improvement of educational services the corresponding diagnostic tool- questionnaire "evaluation of educational course content and its teaching" had been worked out.

Indicators:

The questioning of the students was organized and conducted in 2 stages: from October 14 to 16, 2020 and from February 13 to 19, 2021.

The purpose of the survey is to determine the degree of students' satisfaction with the quality of teaching academic disciplines and professional skills of teachers in the conditions of pandemic. One of the main objectives of the survey is to assess satisfaction with the quality of teaching at the university.

The online form of the questionnaire was created with the help of Google forms and was distributed via a cell phone to the general chat of the students as a link to the questionnaire. Informing about the questionnaire was carried out with the help of department staff. In the survey was attended by students in 133 EP (Table 1) of the 2, 3, 4 years of BA and 1, 2 years of MA. The total number of respondents was 3997 students (bachelor - 3605, master - 392).

Initiative 12.

Development of the program of academic mobility in the interests of quality, accessible education and international cooperation.

Indicators:

Within the program of external academic mobility on the basis of bilateral agreements in the spring semester of 2020-2021 academic year 30 students were trained in foreign partner universities in a distance learning format:

- 3 students - online learning as part of the double degree at the University of Lorraine (France) in the spring semester 2020-2021 academic year;

- 11 students - online training as part of the two-diploma education at the Pomeranian Academy in Slupsk (Poland) in the spring semester of 2020-2021 academic year;

- 10 students - online learning at Adam Mickiewicz University (Poland) in the spring semester 2020-2021 academic year in a distance learning format;

- 2 students - online study at the University of Tsukuba (Japan) in the spring semester 2020-2021 academic year;



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- 1 master's student - online learning at Vilnius University (Lithuania) in the spring semester of academic year 2020-2021;
- 3 students - online learning at the Moscow City Pedagogical University (RF) in the spring semester of academic year 2020-2021.

Under the program of internal academic mobility, on the basis of bilateral agreements with regional universities of Kazakhstan in the spring semester 2020-2021 academic year, 10 students were trained online in KazNPU named after Abay from Aktobe University named after S. Baishev and Atyrau State University named after H. Dosmukhamedov.

The Institute of Pedagogy and Psychology in order to increase academic excellence seeks to provide students with the skills needed in the XXI century: practice-oriented, digital pedagogy, blended learning, results-oriented, humanization of education, research competencies.

Initiative 13.

Improving the quality of education through social partnership

Indicators:

In order to increase the level of formed and developed teaching skills of students, proctoring of pedagogical practice of 3rd and 4th year students, 2nd year undergraduates, as well as 2nd year doctoral students in chemistry, biology, geography was introduced.

Year 3 students attended teachers' classes, while year 4 students, year 2 master's students, and year 2 doctoral students conducted classes according to the schedule, in an online format.

As part of the Continuing Education Practicum, 2,492 University practicum students practiced in schools during the 2020/2021 academic year. There were 3,516 open lessons and 1,817 school activities.

Initiative 14.

Publications in journals with a non-zero impact factor related to research on quality education and education for sustainable development

Indicators:

There are more than 10 publications in journals with a non-zero impact factor related to research on quality education and education for sustainable development

Initiative 15.

There are more than 6 publications in journals with a non-zero impact factor related to research on quality education and education for sustainable development

Initiative 19.

The University promotes the employment of graduates (LRC 8).

Indicators:

1. In order to employ graduates the university annually holds traditional job fairs. Job Fair "Graduate-2021" Education departments and school directors of Almaty region, Nur-Sultan, Almaty, Pavlodar, RUOK "Baldauren", Educational portal "www.bilimland.kz" took part in the job fair. According to the results of the fair, the teachers of mathematics, physics, computer science, elementary school, workers of pre-school educational institutions are in most demand today.

2. For employment of graduates of Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay the Mobile application "Mansap" is developed and introduced, which allows graduate to find vacancies in their place of residence and find a job without extraneous intervention, for employer - to save time for search of the required specialist.

3. In 2020: 95% of graduates are employed; in 2020, 208 graduates are employed in schools by the time they graduate in their teaching internship.

In 2021: 95% of graduates employed: 95% of graduates employed; in 2021, 210 graduates were employed in schools by the time they graduated from the university at their place of teaching practice.

For the academic year 2020/2021 KazNPU named after Abay has partnership relations with 244 employers, including 232 state organizations..

Initiative 20.

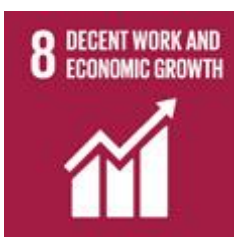
The university strives to create a quality working environment.

Indicators:

In April 2021, a study "Faculty Satisfaction with working conditions at KazNPU named after Abay" was organized. The purpose of the study is to assess the satisfaction of teachers of Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay with working conditions. The main objectives of the study are: identifying features of labor motivation of teachers of the university; determining the degree of teachers' satisfaction with various aspects of work; generalizing proposals and recommendations for improving working conditions; developing recommendations for improving working conditions of the teaching staff. The methodological basis is a mass survey of university teachers. The survey was conducted in the form of an online questionnaire of teachers on a specially designed questionnaire. The online form of the questionnaire was created with the help of Google-forms. A total of 771 teachers, or 73% of the total number of teachers in the nine structural units of the university were surveyed.

The results of the survey showed that the motivating factors for the teachers of KazNPU named after Abay are the possibility of self-fulfillment and the importance of interpersonal relationships in the team (every second). Every third teacher notes the importance of such factors as the prestige of working at the university and the proposed working conditions (schedule, the location of the university, the duration of leave, etc.). It should be noted that the majority of teachers are not motivated by economic incentives. Thus, based on the study, we can recommend the need to improve working conditions for the university as a whole, as well as for its individual units. In particular, it concerns equipping classrooms, laboratories with modern technical means of education, availability and provision with computer, Internet resources and office equipment, social support for teachers, social and everyday aspects of work (classrooms, toilets, canteens).

Initiative 21.

Based on the Learning Ecosystem concept, the university is redefining learning in relation to the rapid development of information technology, systems and resources used, including in education.

Indicators:

The university has research and teaching laboratories: educational physics and engineering, molecular physics, atomic and nuclear physics, optics, digital microelectronics, morphology and physiology, etc.

Linguistic laboratories are equipped with special audio and video systems, computers, microphones, interactive panels.

Computer labs are equipped with 10th generation CoreI5 computers, HP laserjet-2055 printers, CanonMF4410 scanners, Epson multimedia projectors; classrooms with Smart boards, IQBoards; laboratories with modern teaching and laboratory equipment.

Bachelor's and Master's theses are checked for anti-plagiarism in the IS "Univer2.0".

The active network equipment was replaced for the examination testing, the local network was configured in all departments of the university.

The digital infrastructure of the university includes broadband Internet, network and server equipment, computer and peripheral equipment, digital services and resources.

The UNIVER2.0 IS includes the following digital services:

- work of the admissions committee, enrollment order, monitoring;
- management of the students' contingent;
- management of educational activities;
- testing of students;
- formation of examination tickets;
- schedule of classes, exams;
- management of educational-methodical provision;
- monitoring, reports;
- support service, system administration;
- integrated module with ESHEA, NOBD;
- system for checking bachelor's and master's theses for anti-plagiarism;
- automated allocation and issuance of places in the dormitory;
- Aero proctoring system is integrated;
- IS Oqylyk is integrated.

In 2020/2021 academic year in the framework of digitalization of educational activities: the transition to an online mode of learning; for teachers and students implemented MicrosoftOffice 365 platform; implemented control and measurement

of knowledge: used proctoring knowledge control, "Anti-Plagiarism"; management activities: used EDMS "Documentoved"; extracurricular activities: implemented automated issuance of student tickets with QR-code, automated distribution of places in the hostel, online reception documents of applicants.

Improving the digital infrastructure, KazNPU named after Abay consistently modernizes the educational process, integrating the activities of the university in the world standards and trends of modern digital education. In this direction, the university has achieved the following results:

The transition to the digitalization of management processes is completed

Implemented information and analytical system, which integrates: IS "UNIVER 2.0", proctoring system Aero, IS "Anti-Plagiarism", IS Oqylyk.

The digital infrastructure of the university was updated.

In connection with the transition to online learning, the management of the educational process was improved.

Digital transformation meets the requirements of network infrastructure and data protection, ensuring information security of data.

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Initiative 22.

In order to implement SDG 10 the university carries out educational work. This work is aimed at fostering social activity of students and the development of the volunteer movement.

Indicators:

In order to activate and diversify the youth volunteer movement, it is planned to organize and implement activities in the following areas: pedagogical, inclusive, environmental, digital, cultural, legal volunteering, as well as the following social projects:

"Plant a tree".

In order to counteract corruption and ensure the policy of academic integrity in the university opened and successfully operates the center "Parasat". In the academic year 2020-2021 this center together with the DVSR&MP implemented the following activities:

Meetings of students with the university management before the winter and summer examination sessions,

City round table "Adaldyk Alany",

Competition for the best drawing "Corruption in the eyes of children",

A set of activities of the Republican Project Office "Sanaly ұрпақ".

During the summer vacations, 35 students were involved in temporary work in the student labor team. In addition, 15 students were included in the admissions committee, 80 students-volunteers were involved in the census of the Medeu district.

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Initiative 23.

At the university, SDG 11 is implemented through assistance to nonresident and international students of both genders in their new living conditions in Almaty.

Indicators:

The university has 5 well-appointed dormitories for nonresident students for 1,397 places with a total area of 17,159.6 square meters, equipped with living and household rooms, restrooms, reading rooms, computer labs, and showers. All dormitories have access to Wi-Fi.

In order to solve the problem of housing of students, the university together with the investor started the project of construction of a new dormitory for 349 beds in Shukhova street in Medeu district of Almaty, which was allocated by the akimat of the city. The necessary technical documentation is currently being developed. Construction is scheduled to begin in September 2022.

Passing of various kinds of practice, as well as rest of students is organized in the educational-industrial complex "Ұстас" on the northern shore of the Kapchagai water reservoir.

It should be emphasized that the university infrastructure requires serious financial investments, in particular, to improve the territory of the university, major repairs and reconstruction of student dormitories, construction of new dormitories, creating new laboratories, SMART classrooms, as well as "green" spaces, such as Open-spaces.coworking.artzone, etc.

Further strengthening and development of university infrastructure is associated with the transition of the university to international standards of educational services and service development to create a more comfortable learning environment, in accordance with the principles of the concept of "green" university and SDG integration.

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Initiative 24.

SDG 13 at the university is implemented through scientific research.

Indicators:

At the university, the issues and opportunities for the implementation of SDG 13 are considered in the UNESCO project implemented jointly with the University of Okayama for 2021-2024 "Promoting Teacher Education on Climate Change through Cooperation between Asian Centers of Excellence in Education for Sustainable Development" (Japan).

The aim of this study is to develop an "Asian Teacher Education Framework for Climate Change Education Programs" and guide its dissemination through collaboration between centers of excellence in ESD in nine Asian countries: China, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Mongolia, Thailand and the Philippines.

To date, climate change education has been limited to the development of teaching materials and lessons, and teacher training programs focused on practical applications of climate change education are scarce.

This study seeks to remedy that situation.

This study is unique in that it develops, for the first time, a collaborative, research-based framework for climate change education teacher preparation programs.

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Initiative 25.

SDG 15 is implemented at the university through greening the campus and maintaining the concept of a green university

Indicators:

The campus is considerably landscaped. There are both long-standing and new plantings on campus. A beautiful and unusual plant, Pavlonia, the FTE variety, grows on campus.

All of this supports the sustainability of the campus' natural ecosystem.

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Initiative 26.

SDG 16 is implemented at the university through compliance with RK legislation

Indicators:

The University has an Office of Legal Work and Procurement. The main purpose of this Department is the organization, management and control of legal (legal) work and public procurement to ensure the comprehensive activities of the non-profit joint-stock company "Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay.

KazNPU named after Abay considers the internationalization of education as the creation of conditions in which universities are able to cross-fertilize knowledge, technology, experience, resources and cultural traditions.

Indicators 1

International cooperation in the field of education and science is carried out within the framework of international agreements concluded by KazNPU named after Abay with foreign scientific and educational institutions and organizations.

During the academic year 2020-2021 more than 140 international agreements/arrangements were concluded with universities from 33 countries, including 20 agreements with universities included in the Academic Ranking of World Universities (The Academic Ranking of World Universities, ARWU). Among them are such partner universities: (Pennsylvania State University (USA), University of Tsukuba (Japan), Friedrich Alexander University in Erlangen and Nuremberg (Germany), Beijing United University (China), etc.).

Under the program of internal academic mobility, on the basis of bilateral agreements with regional universities of Kazakhstan in the spring semester 2020-2021 academic year 10 students were trained online in KazNPU named after Abay from Aktobe University named after S. Baishev and Atyrau State University named after H. Dosmukhamedov.

Research internship for undergraduates.

According to the State obligatory standard of postgraduate education from May 13, 2016 № 292, as well as within the framework of the NIRM (EIRM), the individual plan of work of a master student provides for compulsory scientific internship in scientific organizations or organizations, relevant industries or spheres of activity. On the basis of interuniversity agreements 344 undergraduates of Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay underwent foreign scientific



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internships in online format in such foreign universities as: Vytautas the Great University (Vilnius, Lithuania), Pomeranian Academy of Slupsk (Poland), Moscow City Pedagogical University (Russian Federation).

External (incoming) academic mobility of teaching staff.

Within the framework of the program "Involvement of foreign professors in the RK universities" for the academic year 2020-2021 year 23 foreign lecturers from foreign partner universities were attracted to give lectures and conduct master classes in online format for the students of Kazakh National Pedagogical University after Abai: Sorbonne University (France), Perpignan University Via Domitia (France); Szent István University (Hungary), Omsk Humanitarian Academy (Russia) Tallinn University (Estonia), Maria Grzegorzewska Academy of Special Pedagogy (Poland), Russian University of People's Friendship (RF), Kazan Federal University (RF), Moscow City Pedagogical University (RF), Armenian State Pedagogical University named after Khachatur Abovyan (RF). The following academic institutions are involved in the study: Akdeniz University (Turkey), Yanka Kupala State University of Grodno (Belarus), Al-Azhar University (Egypt), Mirzo Ulugbek National University of Uzbekistan (Uzbekistan).

External (outgoing) academic mobility of teaching staff.

Motivation for the teaching staff and employees of the University is the results of competitions and scholarships of various international organizations. 2 lecturers of the "Jurisprudence" Chair within the framework of the program "Involvement of foreign lecturers in Belarusian universities" went to the Yanka Kupala State University of Grodno (Belarus) to give a lecture in the Spring semester of 2020-2021 academic year.

During the academic year 2020/2021 academic year in the framework of a joint international project, for participation in international symposia, conferences and round tables 27 teachers in their fields of study were trained in eight European universities on external (outgoing) academic mobility University of California Sacramento (USA), University of Lorraine (France), University of Leipzig (Germany), Yanka Kupala State University of Grodno (Belarus), Moscow City Pedagogical University (Russia), Istanbul University (Turkey), University of Foreign Languages and Culture (Germany).

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
