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FAQ - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

COMPUTER TESTING

|| OFFLINE TESTING - TRADITIONAL

Description: The exam is taken by the student right in the classroom according to the schedule. The examiner oversees the testing process and enforces the rules of academic integrity.

Platform used – UNIVER

Exam format - Offline format (in a computer class)

Exam duration and number of questions:

• 45 minutes for one subject

Note: The countdown will start from the moment you click on the "Go to the exam" button

Schedule - The time and date of the exam can be viewed in the system Univer - Schedule - Schedule of exams.

Seats will be published 30 minutes before the start of the exam in the Univer system - News

The exam is scheduled. Students and teachers should be informed in advance about the exam schedule - the responsibility of the leadership of the departments and the institute

The assessment of the final control (exam) can be canceled at any time by the Testing Center based on the results of the behavior check in case of revealing the academic dishonesty of the student. We ask all students to observe ethical and moral standards, do not break the rules or commit academic dishonesty when taking the exam, as this may lead to the cancellation of the assessment.

ALGORITHM FOR CARRYING OUT COMPUTER TESTING IN THE TRADITIONAL FORMAT

- 1. Testing is carried out according to the approved schedule.
- 2. Testing takes place in the Univer system using proctoring.
- 3. Entrance to the audience is allowed only with an identity document of the student and a boarding list.
- 4. The student takes all subjects prohibited during the exam. Entrance to persons not participating in testing is strictly prohibited.
- 5. The student signs in the turnout list and takes the place indicated in the landing list
- 6. The countdown will start from the moment you click on the "Go to the exam" button
- 7. The exam page will display Questions (5 questions per page)
- 8. After answering all the questions, the student presses the Finish button
- 9. Next, log out of the Univer account

COMPUTER TESTING

|| ONLINE TESTING

Description: the student undergoes identification, the test is supervised by an automatic proctoring system.

Used platform – UNIVER + PROCTORING

The exam format is online using digital platforms.

Exam duration and number of questions:

• Bachelor's, Master's and DOT - 60 minutes, 40 questions each

Note: The countdown will start from the moment you click on the "Start" button in the extension

Proctoring - Automated proctoring system with artificial intelligence.

You will need:

- Login and password from the Univer system (Your Advisor or Dean's office can recover your password)
- Website <u>e.kaznpu.kz</u>
- Quiet, well-lit room
- Reliable Internet connection (you can check <u>here</u> 1Mbps required)
- Computer or laptop

ATTENTION: IT IS FORBIDDEN TO TAKE THE TEST FROM A SMARTPHONE! AUTOMATIC CANCEL!

Your computer must be equipped with:

- Front camera (webcam test here)
- Microphone

Install:

- Google Chrome browser latest version (download Chrome)
- Proctoring extension (<u>download extension</u>)

The assessment of the final control (exam) can be canceled at any time by the Testing Center based on the results of the behavior check in case of revealing the academic dishonesty of the student. ALGORITHM FOR CARRYING OUT COMPUTER TESTING IN ONLINE FORMAT

- 1. Testing is carried out according to the approved schedule.
- 2. Testing takes place in the Univer system using proctoring.
- 3. The countdown will start from the moment you click on the "Go to the exam" button
 - proctoring system records screen and webcam recordings;
- 4. The exam page will display Questions (5 questions per page)
- 5. After answering all the questions, the student presses the Finish button
- 6. Sign out of your Univer account

COMPUTER TESTING RULES

|| STUDENTS ARE PROHIBITED

ATTENTION: IT IS FORBIDDEN TO TAKE THE TEST FROM A SMARTPHONE!

- It is forbidden to take the exam from the phone (answers sent from the smartphone are canceled immediately)
- You must be in a quiet, well-lit area without bystanders.
- Your ears must be clearly visible (necessary to collect hair before the exam)
- Your face must be clearly visible (the face must not be out of focus of the camera)
- It is forbidden to use headphones
- It is forbidden to use auxiliary materials: mobile devices, notes or textbooks
- It is forbidden to copy and memorize answers from other sources
- It is forbidden to communicate with anyone during testing
- Don't take your eyes off the screen
- Under no circumstances switch the test window in the browser
- Any third party webcam applications are prohibited
- It is forbidden to use a second monitor or any software for remote screen access or display.

- It is forbidden to turn off the Internet

A WRITTEN EXAM

|| OPEN BOOK

Description: the form of the exam, when students are allowed to use any reference, educational literature and the Internet. Tasks in the form of cases or essays.

Platform used - Oqylyq LMS

The exam format is online using digital platforms.

Exam duration - 7 days (5 days for work and 2 days for checking by the teacher)

Number of questions - 1 essay or case topic

Proctoring - **Disabled**

Anti-plagiarism - Enabled

Attaching Files to Reply Box - Disabled

You will need:

- Login and password from the Oqylyq system
 - Website <u>app.oqylyq.kz</u>
 - Login use the login from the Univer system
 - Password 123456
- Reliable internet connection
- Computer or laptop

ALGORITHM FOR CONDUCTING A WRITTEN EXAM WITH AN OPEN BOOK

- 1. At the specified time, the student will have access to the exam on the **app.oqylyq.kz** website.
- 2. Using the login from the Univer system and the password 123456, the student enters the site and selects an exam.
- 3. A ticket is generated for each student automatically.
- 4. The anti-plagiarism exam begins:
 - 4.1. The student rewrites the topic of an essay or case onto a sheet
 - 4.2. Closes a browser tab
- After writing his work, he returns to the site "app.oqylyq.kz" opens the same exam.
 5.1. Copies and pastes the text of the completed work into the response field.
- 6. Upon completion of the exam, the student presses the "Finish" button.
- 7. At the end of the exam, the teacher and the reviewer check the students' work.

IMPORTANT! Only works that pass uniqueness through anti-plagiarism can be evaluated. Uniqueness: Bachelor's degree - not less than 40%, Master's degree - not less than 55%

8. After evaluating all the works, the teacher transfers the points to the statement in the Univer system manually.

A WRITTEN EXAM

|| CLOSED BOOK

Description: is the most "usual" form, when the student sees the questions for the first time and writes the answers. During the exam, the student's behavior is monitored by a proctoring system.

Platform used - Oqylyq LMS

The exam format is a combined (online or offline) format.

Exam duration - from 60 minutes to 90 minutes (exams where formulas in the answer are used can be extended up to 180 minutes at the discretion of the teacher)

Number of questions - 3 questions (2 theoretical and 1 practical.)

Proctoring - Enabled

Anti-plagiarism - Enabled

Attaching Files to Reply Box - Disabled

You will need:

- Login and password from the Oqylyq system
 - Website <u>app.oqylyq.kz</u>
 - Login use the login from the Univer system
 - Password 123456
- Quiet, well-lit room
- Reliable internet connection
- Computer or laptop

Your computer must be equipped with:

- Front camera (webcam test here)
- Microphone

ALGORITHM FOR CONDUCTING A WRITTEN EXAM WITH A CLOSED BOOK

- 1. At the specified time, the student will have access to the exam on the **app.oqylyq.kz** website.
- 2. Using the login from the Univer system and the password 123456, the student enters the site and selects an exam.
- 3. A ticket is generated for each student automatically.
- 4. The exam begins with mandatory proctoring: you need a laptop or smartphone.
- 5. The student receives 3 generated questions, then answers in the answer field.
- 6. After answering all the questions, the student presses the "Finish" button.
- 7. At the end of the exam, the teacher and the reviewer check the students' work.
- 8. After evaluating all the works, the teacher transfers the points to the statement in the Univer system manually.

WRITTEN EXAM RULES CLOSED BOOK

|| STUDENTS ARE PROHIBITED

- Your face must be clearly visible (the face must not be out of focus of the camera)

PRACTICE EXAM - MICROSOFT TEAMS

Description: The student performs practical tasks. Defends completed tasks before the commission.

Platform used – Microsoft Teams

Exam format - Getting the task and attaching the answer remotely, Protection traditionally, in the classroom according to the approved schedule.

Exam duration - 7 days (of which 5 days for work and 1 day for defense with a commission and 1 day for grading)

Number of questions - from 15 to 100 practical tasks

Proctoring - **Disabled**

Anti-plagiarism - Disabled

Time to answer - the answer of each student to one question should not exceed 5 minutes

- Login and password from Microsoft Teams
 - Website Login and password can be found in the system Univer -Bachelor (Master)
- Reliable internet connection
- Computer or laptop

Install:

- Google Chrome browser latest version (download Chrome)
- Microsoft Teams for work and school (download Microsoft Teams)

STUDENTS ARE PROHIBITED:

Send the exam paper by e-mail or instant messengers (WhatsApp, Telegram, etc.).

ALGORITHM FOR CARRYING OUT THE PRACTICAL EXAM

- 1. At the specified time, each student begins to complete all attached tasks in the Microsoft Teams program.
- 2. The student logs in through his account login@abaiuniversity.edu.kz. Next, Teams \rightarrow Go to the team you need \rightarrow Tasks
- 3. A list of tasks is displayed, transfers them to Word or downloads, closes Microsoft Teams and proceeds to complete the tasks.
- 4. After writing his work, he returns to the Microsoft Teams program, opens the Assignment, attaches the work using the Attach button.
- 5. Presses the "Submit" button.
- 6. The teacher and the commission, together with the students, conduct defense in the classroom or online using Microsoft Teams or Zoom according to the schedule. The instructor must start recording the meeting.
- 7. The teacher decides which of the practical tasks each student will answer.
- 8. The teacher and the commission rate each student.
- 9. After evaluating all the works, the teacher transfers the points to the Univer system record manually.

PROJECT EXAM - MICROSOFT TEAMS

Description: One or a group of students performs one project work. Defend(s) the work before the commission.

Platform used – Microsoft Teams (Zoom)

Exam format– Getting the task and attaching the answer remotely, Protection - traditionally, in the classroom according to the approved schedule.

Exam duration - 7 days (of which 5 days for work and 1 day for defense with a commission and 1 day for grading)

Number of questions - 1 project topic is issued for one or a group of students.

ALGORITHM FOR CARRYING OUT THE PROJECT

- 1. At the specified time, each student begins to complete all attached tasks in the Microsoft Teams program.
- The student logs in through his account login@abaiuniversity.edu.kz. Next, Teams
 → Go to the team you need → Tasks
- 3. The student or group selects and analyzes topics, then closes Microsoft Teams and proceeds to complete assignments.
- 4. After writing his work, he returns to the Microsoft Teams program, opens the Assignment, attaches the work using the Attach button.
- 5. Presses the "Submit" button.
- 6. The teacher and the commission, together with the students, conduct defense in the classroom or online using Microsoft Teams or Zoom according to the schedule. The teacher must start recording the meeting
- 7. Students defend the project that they submitted in advance in the Assignments section.
- 8. The teacher and the commission rate each student
- 9. After evaluating all the works, the teacher transfers the points to the Univer system record manually.

|| FAQ - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

|| I forgot my username or password, what should I do?

1. You can get the **login and password from the Univer** system from your Advisor, he (a) will also be able to reset the password.

2. You can find your Microsoft Teams login and password on your Univer system page. Go to the website of the Univer system → Bachelor (Master) → On the last line you will see your login and password from Microsoft Teams

3. Login and password from Oqylyq LMS - on the website app.oqylyq.kz in the login field, **enter your login from the Univer** system, in the **password field enter - 123456.** (The password can be changed in the Profile tab - Under the full name, click on edit - Change password)

Practical / Project Exam (Microsoft Teams) - the student must report the problem to the teacher leading this discipline.

|| What is FX and how to apply?

In case of receiving an "unsatisfactory" grade corresponding to the "FX" mark (25-49 points), the student has the opportunity to retake the final control without re-passing the program of the academic discipline/module during the interim assessment period and during the holidays before the start of the next academic period. The algorithm for applying for a retake is "**Univer System** \rightarrow **Bachelor** \rightarrow **Retake**". FX retake days will be announced in the Univer system after the main session.

During testing with proctoring, a failure occurred, what should I do?

. If a student has a failure in computer testing with proctoring, then he (a) can fill out a retake form on the <u>retake.kaznpu.kz</u> website for technical reasons. After submitting the form, the commission will review the application and make a decision. The list of students approved by the commission and the date for the retake will be announced in the Univer **system after the main session**.
